## Student Dress Code

### **Shirts: Solid color with collar.**

Includes polo style, button down, turtleneck, long or short sleeves, cotton or cotton blend. **Not permitted:** satin, 100% polyester. Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in at all times.

### **Pants/Shorts: Traditional dress style in navy, black or tan.**

Must be hemmed and worn at the waist. Shorts may not extend below the knee nor rise more than 4 inches above the knee. **Not permitted:** Oversized, jean style, low cut, flares, carpenter, drawstrings, zip-off, large pockets, stretch or denim.

### **Skirts/Skorts/Jumpers: Navy, black or tan.**

These may not be shorter than 4 inches above the knee. Tights allowed in white, crème, brown, blue, black or natural tone hose.

### **Sweaters & Vests: Solid color pullover, cardigans or vests worn with collared shirt.**

**Not permitted:** hoods or sweatshirts. South Arbor logo sweatshirts are permitted.

### **Footwear: Single color shoe in white, black, navy, brown or burgundy.**

Sole only may be of different color. Solid color socks must be worn and shoelaces tied at all times. **Not permitted:** Light up shoes, outerwear boots, sandals, clogs, open toe or open back, heels above 1 ½ inches or shoes more than 1 inch above ankle.

### **Personal ID Badge: Students are not permitted in the classroom without an ID badge.**

Badges must be worn on the collar. Badges will remain at school at the end of the day. A replacement cost of \$3 will be assessed and collected by the homeroom teacher if a student's badge is lost or destroyed.

### **Jewelry: Not permitted except for watches and one pair of stud earrings.**

**Not Permitted:** hoop earrings, make-up—clear or otherwise, artificial nails or nail polish, hats as classroom attire, bandanas, extreme hairstyles, or unnatural hair coloring.

### **Special Events Dress:**

Field Trips: At the discretion of the teacher.

Jean Day: Jeans and a dress code shirt. **Not permitted:** Low cut or excessively baggy jeans, non dress code shirt. No jewelry as above.

Fall Yearbook Picture Day: The yearbook picture is to be taken in dress code.

Spring Personal Picture Day: Students may wear dress code or better according to parental judgment.

**Personal Hygiene:** Students should be clean and neat when at school, or attending any school function, including field trips. Students are expected to maintain proper hygiene throughout the day by washing their hands before eating and after using the restroom.

**Dress Code Compliance:** Students will be monitored for dress code compliance at the beginning of the day. Students found not to be in compliance will be required to either contact parents to have dress code clothing brought to school or to wear clothing kept at the school for such purposes. Students will not be able to return to the classroom until dress code compliant clothing is obtained.
